Minutes of Annual General Meeting, 13th March 2021 via Zoom

Apologies for absence were received from Jamie Edgar.

Minutes of last year's AGM issued .in advance and available on website. The meeting agreed that they were a true record.

Matters Arising—None

Secretary's Report —Issued in advance and available on website. The verbal presentation added that Backworth CC joined CN in January 2021.

League Managers Reports—2020 leagues not played due to Covid 19 restrictions.

CA Representative's Report.—.(Written Report attached to these minutes Dennis Scarr presented a comprehensive report to the meeting about changes within the CA and asks the question, to CN and Clubs, 'Do we have the capacity to deal with what is coming our way and if we don't what are we going to do to prepare ourselves?' Roger Staples followed with comments on—the update of Covid guidelines on the CA website, —the need for clubs to maintain Risk Assessments—the introduction of new AC Laws—the update of the website for the CA Shop.

Roger also mentioned the demanding work currently in progress to ensure diversity within croquet. Sport England 'Active Partnerships' encourages sport for all but its success is very dependant upon regional activity.—Development grants remain available from the CA.

2020 Accounts —Issued in advance with supporting commentary. (Year end balance £3114). The Accounts were accepted.

There were no other nominees. All of the above were elected. Election of independent person to verify accounts —David Appleton.

(Club appointed representatives last year were John Howie (Alnmouth), Terry Vernazza (Tyneside), Eric Nixon (Belsay), Roger Carpenter (Durham), Eugene Brady (Auckland). Charles Waterfield (Middlesbrough) Don Morton (Backworth) from January 2021. Bamburgh have chosen not to take up their vacancy. No changes have been advised).

Plans for Leagues and Championships—Both League Managers (Julian Gibson and Colin Chun) had contacted club representatives. Following discussion it was agreed that because of Covid 19 related uncertainties Championships would probably proceed soon but it was too early to be sure about the timing and format for leagues.

Plans for other Events A provisional Fixtures List had been circulated and this was updated at the meeting but there remain outstanding decisions to be made by potential organisers.. The Secretary will update the list and circulate to all who have an action. Confirmed events will be uploaded to the website under Calendar.

Development and Coaching—Nothing to report.

Budget Proposals for 2021- The Treasurer's report made reference to trying to gradually reduce end of year balances, but there was also recognition that some expenditure maybe necessary for trophy engraving (not always covered by fees) and that some expenditure may be necessary to support the implementation of the plans outlined by Dennis Scarr in his CA Representatives Report. The Executive Committee proposal for the membership fee this year was £10/club and after discussion this was carried (Phil Errington was against and Eugene Brady abstained).

Jane Pringle advised that she was holding the CN GC Northern League Trophy which had been held by Ripon Spa CC.

Communications -John Fitzpatrick advised that, because of inactivity last year, there was little to put into a newsletter. If photos or articles of interest were sent to him he would attempt to put something together, otherwise it would a matter of publicising reports/papers and preparing Entry Forms. Nigel Martin reported that monitoring of the website had shown, on average over the past few weeks, 1 or 2 'hits' per day.

AOB—Phill Errington, on behalf of those attending (and representing 7 of our 8 clubs) thanked all involved in the organising and the running of this first CN AGM via Zoom.
